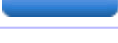

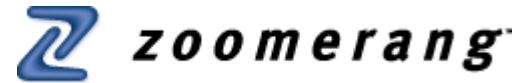

5. Please share your suggestions for how we could make future sessions more beneficial.	
#	Response
1	More spacious meeting places and more times offered.
2	Perhaps smaller groups for those who might be uncomfortable sharing feelings or ideas, or asking questions in a large group. Another thought is for those who work in the building where the Town Hall Session took place-- were employees bosses there? That may inhibit someone from speaking out.
3	Offer additional sessions... I know that there are a number of employees who did not have a chance to attend one of the programs.
